Project Description

The ESC volunteer will assist one experienced, native English speaker within the school by teaching English. This will take place during class lessons and for extra hands such as reading and further small group activities. Furthermore, the volunteer can set up projects for an eTwinning knowledge exchange. Throughout the year, the Juliana van Stolberg school participates in different sports tournaments on the Wednesday afternoons and in the weekends. The tournaments are usually soccer, hockey, basketball and swimming. The volunteer can assist here as well. Active citizenship is also an important pillar at the Juliana van Stolberg school. The social and societal competences are relevant when the children leave primary school, and it is fundamental for a democratic society. To improve the awareness of how democracy works, Juliana van Stolberg school will start up a project. E.g. the school will invite an alderman of the municipality to explain about the different political parties and the importance of democracy. The ESC volunteer will develop new activities such as playing games during short breaks and lunch breaks. Ideas for this can be taken from the foundations TEAMUP.

Depending on the interest and talents of the volunteer, he/she can help the professional with cultural activities for example, music, dance, act, craftsmanship or physical education. During the summer holidays the ESC volunteer will organise several activities together with other ESC volunteers.
