The leaders can create and teach workshops and other activities that are aligned to Euroweek pillars of activities. All activities would not only benefit the students but also contribute to growth of the Youth Leader as individual, team player and leader.

At the end of the program, the leaders are expected to gain and develop not only their language, teaching, and leadership skills, but also their inter-cultural knowledge, problem-solving skills, and management skills.

- 8. Willing to travel to different places around Poland
- 9. Able to be in a flexible environment and available for all the activities on a daily basis
- 10. Willing to be involved, to learn and to live with other International Youth Leaders from different countries
- 11. Eager to create, develop and facilitate different activities such life skills workshop, team building games, creativity workshops, etc.

Duties and Responsibilities of Youth Leaders/ Interns/Volunteers

The Youth Leaders are responsible in facilitating the daily schedule of activities for the students as directed by the program's Rules and Regulation.

The following details are the duties and responsibilities of the Youth Leaders:

- 1. In charge in facilitating the offline and online activities of Euroweek Program
- 2. Assisting in managing the schedules of the program and group of students
- 3. Assisting in administrative and other international affairs of the program (upon request of the intern)
- 4. Assist in marketing campaigns and acquisition of database
- 5. Conduct country presentation and perform traditional dances and songs
- 6. Facilitate various activities such as life skills workshop, team building games, creativity workshops, attend group discussion, attend teachers meeting
- 7. Attend local, International trips, walking to mountains, and other attractions nearby
- 8. Support other teams/hotels if needed such as doing country presentations and facilitates different activities
- 9. Follow the rules and regulation of the program

Profile of our Students

We are proud to say that we are a partner of hundreds of Schools around Poland.

- Our students are coming from primary, jr. high school, high school and adult learners who are coming from different parts of Poland.
- All activities in the program are in the presence of the teachers and guidance of the students.
- We are also having International Participants from Turkey, China, Indonesia, Germany, and Azerbaijan every summer.
- Each group of students is staying for 5 days. It means every 5 days we are having new batches of students and the activities are repeating to different batches of the students who are coming next.
- We have students and schools who are repeatedly coming to the program from 10-18 times as per our records.
- Maximum in a week we have 700 -1000 Polish students.
- All the activities are happening in different hotels and in each hotel we have a team of Youth Leaders and Team Leaders/Coordinators who facilitate the activities of the program.

Venue of The Activities

Euroweek program operates mainly 7 hotels where all the students are accommodated with their chaperones (teachers and headmasters). Most of the activities will take place inside the hotels.

Each hotel has a team which consist of 4-7 Youth Leaders/Interns and they are headed and guided by their Team Leader/Coordinator. All Youth Leaders can be transferred from one team to another time to time.

Accommodation

All Youth Leaders are living together and accommodated in 5 different flats around Klodzko Region. Here, they will have a chance to make new colleagues around the world, know more about their countries and personal cultures.

All houses are equipped with kitchen and general utensils needed for daily living. All rooms are shared with 2-5 youth leaders depending on the location. The place of the accommodation per Youth Leader will be chosen based on the date of the arrival and the team that they will belong to.

Local transportation assistance during the program is provided. It means the transfer from the house of the leaders to each hotel where they need to facilitate the activities.

Supermarkets are reachable by trains and buses.

Details of Financial Support

The Youth Leaders will receive a monthly allowance for food amounting 360 ZL and another 360 ZL for pocket money. (See table 1 below for further illustration)
